

Open Bull Ride: \$2,000

The most popular and most dangerous rodeo event! A rope straps a man's hand to a tonne of explosive power.

To keep his position and balance, a bull rider is constantly grabbing for new holds with his feet and continually pulling up the rope.

The harder the bull bucks and the faster he spins, the more points the ride is worth.



Bareback Riding: \$1,500

A very demanding event for the competitor from the moment the gate opens.


A suitcase-like handle is attached to the top of the leather rigging around the horse's girth. The contestant grips this handle with one hand, keeps his other free and high in the air.

Ideally bareback riders want to spur the horse on each jump, reaching as far forward as they can with their feet, and then jerking their feet upwards towards the rigging.

Saddle Bronc: \$1,500

Considered the classic rodeo event, this competition is definitely not for beginners. Since there is nothing solid to hold on to, a cowboy can only stay in the saddle through timing and balance.

The proven rider deliberately matches his spurring strides with the bucking bronc's rhythm beneath him, making the whole ride appear smooth.



Steer Wrestling: \$1,500

An event that requires not only speed and agility but also physical size and strength.

The cowboy drops from the side of a galloping horse onto a running steer and throws him to the ground, overcoming odds heavily weighed in the cattle's favour.

The steer wrestler is allowed a partner called a 'hazer' to aid him in lining up the charging steer. This assistance helps to assume perfect placement of the steer and horse before the cowboy dismounts.

The time stops after the contestant has turned the steers head and all four feet are out in the same direction.

Team Roping: \$1,500

On the open range it is often necessary to catch an animal in order to attend to it. This is where team roping first took place.

The competition starts when the header leaves the box in pursuit of the runaway steer. His job is to rope the steer's horns, wrap the loose end of the rope around the saddle horn and turn the steer's hind legs away from his partner.

The heeler then ropes the steer's hind legs also tying to the saddle horn. The header and heeler then face their horse towards the steer and the timer stops. Definitely a favourite of many.



Ladies Open & Novice Barrel Race: \$1,500

This all-female event tests the speed and agility of both cowgirl and horse. The timer is set in motion when girl and horse cross the starting line and is stopped when she recrosses that line.

The rider and her mount must make two turns in one direction and one in the other direction around the barrels. These barrels are set in a triangle pattern a set distance apart.

There is a 5 second penalty for an overturned barrel which can be devastating especially when differences in times are often down to hundredths of a second.



Rope & Tie: \$1,500

Roping is a race against time with seconds counted in decimal points. To win, the horse and rider must work together in precision teamwork.

The contest begins when the calf is released from the Chute with horse and rider chasing behind. A good horse will carry its rider alongside the calf's every move then stop and back up when the rope is thrown, pulling the rope taut.

The rider dismounts, runs down the rope, throws the calf and ties any three legs together with pigging string. The timer stops when the cowboy's hands are in the air. The rider must remount his horse and slacken the rope for 6 seconds to prove the hold.



Breakaway Roping: \$1,500

The female version of rope & tie. The event differs in that the cowgirl does not have to dismount the horse and tie the calf's legs.

Instead the rope is tired to the saddle horn with a ribbon. When the calf is roped the horse is pulled up causing the rope to grow taut until the ribbon breaks. This is when the timer is stopped.

Steer Undecorating: \$1,500


The female version of steer wrestling. Rather than having to slide over the side of the galloping horse and stop the steer, the cowgirl has to catch up to the steer and remove the ribbon attached to its back.

Like the steer wrestling, the cowgirl is allowed a 'hazer' to aid her in lining up the charging steer. Time is taken when she removes the ribbon from the steer and raises it high over her head.

Novice Bull Ride: \$1,500

This is for the bull-riders who are one step away from making it into the big league of the open bull ride. Often the bulls can be just as big and feisty giving the cowboys the best learning experience they can receive. A great way to spur the learning cowboys into the big time.


